HP Crop Diversification Promotion Project (JICA)

HP Crop Diversification Promotion Project (JICA) also sponsored one training programme for their staff at SAMETI. 24 number of officers participated in this two days workshop/training programme.



National Level and MANAGE Sponsored Programs:

A. National Institute of Agricultural Extension Management (MANAGE) Hyderabad: SAMETI Mashobra in collaboration with MANAGE Hyderabad organized training programs on online and off line mode for the officers of Agriculture and allied departments. During this year two number of training programs were organized on the topic "Five days Training cum Exposure

Visit of Master Trainers on Natural Farming" in which 56 number of Scientists from ATARI Zone I and II are trained as master trainers on natural farming. Beside this SAMETI also organized trainings for consultants of PK3Y to know the impact of natural farming in the State and its benefits for the farming community.

B. Diploma in Agricultural Extension Services for Input Dealers (DAESI):

The National Institute of Agricultural Extension Management (MANAGE) has developed a comprehensive one-year diploma course titled "Diploma in Agricultural Extension Services for Input Dealers (DAESI)." This program is specifically tailored to provide input dealers with the necessary agricultural education, customized to their respective locations. The aim is to empower these dealers with adequate knowledge to effectively serve as para-extension professionals, capable of addressing the daily challenges encountered by farmers at the grassroots level.

DAESI has been meticulously structured to ensure minimal disruption to the input dealers' regular business activities. The program spans 48 weeks, featuring 40 classroom sessions supplemented by 8 field visits. Importantly, all sessions are conveniently scheduled on Sundays or market holidays, allowing participants to balance their educational pursuits with

their business commitments seamlessly.

Through a combination of theoretical learning and practical exposure, DAESI equips input dealers with the skills and insights necessary to serve as valuable resources for farmers in their communities. By enhancing their understanding of agricultural practices, market dynamics, and rural development strategies, the program empowers participants to make meaningful contributions to the agricultural ecosystem while simultaneously advancing their own professional growth.

The National Institute of Agricultural Extension Management (MANAGE) has initiated this program in collaboration with State Agricultural Management and Extension Training Institutes (SAMETIs). In the year 2023-24, SAMETI Mashobra started five batches of input dealers in district Kangra (2 batches), Mandi, Una, and Sirmaur, with each batch comprising 40 participants.



C. Post Graduate Diploma in Agricultural Extension Management (PGDAEM):

Transforming subsistence agriculture into profitable agriculture is a great challenge before the extension functionaries in India. It is a well known fact that farmers' need for the latest knowledge has risen as the focus shifted from subsistence to profitable agriculture, where as, the knowledge of the public extension functionaries has not enhanced adequately due to their engagement in multifarious activities and lack of opportunities for knowledge and skill up gradation. As a result, the knowledge gap between the challenges ahead and existing capabilities among extension functionaries has been widened.

In order to bridge this ever increasing gap in knowledge, a Post Graduate Diploma in Agricultural Extension Management (PGDAEM) at MANAGE has been launched for the agricultural extension functionaries. It is expected that the diploma would create a professional cadre of farm advisors in the country who eventually would take forward the agenda of agricultural extension.

During the year 2023 – 24 one batch of PGDAEM having 16 number of candidates is completed.



D. Skill Training for Rural Youth (STRY):

Skill Training for Rural Youth is a flagship scheme of the Government. The Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare, Govt. of India, in compliance with National Policy on Skill Development & Entrepreneurship 2015, has taken the initiative to implement the skill development component, namely Skill Development of Rural Youth (STRY) under Sub Mission on Agricultural Extension (SMAE) of National Mission on Agricultural Extension & Technology (NMAET) during 2015-16 and remaining period of XII Plan.

STRY is aimed at imparting skill based training to rural youth on agri- based vocational areas in agriculture and allied areas to promote employment of rural area and creation of skilled manpower.

National institute of Agriculture Extension Management (MANAGE), Ministry of Agriculture and Farmer Welfare at national level coordinates through SAMETI to implement this scheme. During 2023-24 four number of trainings has been conducted on the following skilling areas:
